Student support services help students become more aware of their potential and include counseling, academic advisement, placement testing, career planning, job placement, and financial assistance.


The College's 46-acre Elko campus borders Interstate 80 less than a mile northeast of downtown Elko. The beautiful campus features a landmark clock tower, a glass solarium, a state-of-the-art amphitheatre and a pristine waterway.

Great Basin College's service area includes five expansive counties—Elko, Eureka, Humboldt, Lander, and White Pine. These counties contain more than 46,000 square miles. The College service area covers a 200-mile swath of the Great Basin between the Bonneville Salt Flats in the east and the Black Rock Desert in the west.

GBC country extends from Denio on the Nevada-Oregon border to Baker on Nevada-Utah line. This land is often called "high desert" because the minimum elevation averages more than a mile above sea level.

Within the College service area are great potato fields around Winnemucca, some of the world's largest ranches, and several snow-mantled mountain ranges, some of which grow the Bristlecone Pine, oldest of living things.
