Minneapolis Community and Technical College is the only urban, two-year comprehensive college in Minnesota, enrolling more than 10,000 students each year in liberal arts, career and technical programs. The college is also the most ethnically diverse campus in the state, with more than 80 languages and unique dialects spoken on campus.

MCTC students can earn an associate degree, diploma or certificate in a wide variety of career/technical programs designed to help them enter the workforce quickly. If the goal is to complete a baccalaureate degree, students can take their first two years of liberal arts classes at MCTC and finish their degree at a four-year college.

MCTC has a reputation for providing innovative career training in fields such as health, business, manufacturing, communication, and computer technology. The college offers the Urban Teacher Program; the state's first nursing pathway (nursing assistant to L.P.N. to A.D.N. to B.S.N. (through an articulation agreement with Metropolitan State University)); and the only two-year degrees in filmmaking, video production and sound arts in Minnesota. The law enforcement program trains close to 50 percent of the state's police force.

The tuition rate is among the most affordable in the state. Financial aid and many scholarships are available.

MCTC is located in the heart of downtown Minneapolis on beautiful Loring Park. ♦

Rainy River Community College is located in northern Minnesota and is situated right along the Canadian border. Just minutes from campus you can access a wilderness campsite in a world class national park, fish a hot spot on the lake or river, get a fast food meal, see a movie, or visit a Native American museum in Canada. The setting is a small, secure community of about 6700 people nestled between a lake, a river, a national park, and Canada.

The 80-acre campus has an 8-building complex connected with heated walkways enclosing a landscaped courtyard. The grounds feature an observatory for the study of astronomy, a softball field, tennis courts, lighted cross-country skiing and hiking trails, and three ponds edged by decks and walkways. The adjacent student housing offers furnished apartment style accommodations for students.

We offer course work in a variety of subjects including International Business, Accounting, Art, Biology, Business, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, English, Film, Geography, German, Health, History, Humanities, Indigenous Studies, Business Management, Marketing, Math, Music, Natural Science, Nursing, Philosophy, Physical Education, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, Spanish, Speech, Theater, and Outdoor Leadership. ♦
