Innovative Programs

Wayne State's four schools — Arts and Humanities, Business and Technology, Education and Counseling, and Natural and Social Sciences — offer a comprehensive selection of courses in 14 academic departments. Fine and performing arts students perform in the newly-renovated Ramsey Theatre and the Lied Performing Arts Center.

The Rural Health Opportunities Program (RHOP) provides training in medicine, pharmacy and dentistry in cooperation with the University of Nebraska Medical Center. Students who successfully complete the program at WSC are accepted into medical, pharmacy, or dental school at UNMC. A similar program, MARHOP, is offered in conjunction with Creighton University in Omaha.

The School of Business and Technology offers majors in computer information systems and 11 specialized areas of business administration as well as a teacher preparation major in business education.

Upper-level education majors at Wayne State have the opportunity to participate in the Northeast Nebraska Teacher Academy (NENTA), the first and only one of its kind in the nation, where WSC students receive classroom substitute teaching experience in participating K-12 schools.

Excellent Career Preparation

In addition to classes taught by experts in their fields, Wayne State College provides internship and cooperative programs. Many regional businesses recruit our students for internships, with many of these internships leading to full-time employment.

Personal Attention

With an average class size of 21 and a student/faculty ratio of 19:1, WSC students get to know their professors and classmates. Nearly eighty percent of Wayne State professors have the highest degree in their field—and many teach first-year as well as upper-level classes.

The heart of the Wayne State campus is the student center. Academic and personal support services such as The Learning Center and Peer Tutoring program are designed to help students achieve the highest possible level of success.

Scenic Surroundings

Wayne State's beautiful campus is located in the northeast Nebraska community of Wayne. The campus combines stately, historic buildings with newly-renovated facilities.

Wayne State's seven residence halls provide students a comfortable, affordable and conveniently located place to live.

Each hall has lounges and recreation areas, laundry facilities, mail service, academic tutors and study areas. The halls are wired for access to the campus computer network from students' personal computers. All Wayne State residence halls are smoke-free.

Active Campus Life

With more than 85 clubs and organizations on campus, Wayne State students have many opportunities to be involved in campus and community life. The Student Activities Board (SAB) plans a variety of special events featuring musical groups and various national performers.

The Multicultural Center provides outreach and support through special events such as Native American Month, Dr. Martin Luther King Day, Black History Month, and more.

NCAA Division II Athletics

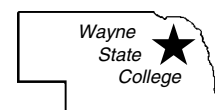
