## New certification program for corporate-Aboriginal relations

On February 17th the Legislative Assembly of the Federation of Saskatchewan Indian Nations (FSIN) passed a motion “recognizing and endorsing” the Canadian Council for Aboriginal Business’ (CCAB) Progressive Aboriginal Relations Program.

The Progressive Aboriginal Relations (PAR) program is a unique certification program and strategic management tool that sets the standard for corporate-Aboriginal relations. PAR companies incorporate best practices and track their performance for the achievement of business objectives and continual improvement in four performance areas of Aboriginal relations:

- Business Development: The commitment of resources to business relationships with Aboriginal owned businesses.
- Employment: The commitment of resources to achieving equitable representation of Aboriginal persons.
- Community Investment: The gift of resources that are provided voluntarily to an Aboriginal community or group.
- Community Engagement: A commitment of resources to develop or maintain constructive relations with aboriginal communities or groups.

The certification process includes a rigorous self-assessment, performance review by an external verifier, and Jury review resulting in certification at the Bronze, Silver, or Gold level.

The PAR program was designed to recognize smart and effective engagement with Aboriginal businesses and communities as part

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of a company’s overall strategic plan. In 2011 the program will introduce an online platform, progressive participation levels and additional best practices in corporate social responsibility.

CCAB is a national member-based organization for Aboriginal businesses, Aboriginal community owned economic development corporations, and companies operating in Canada. CCAB’s programs include the Aboriginal Business Hall of Fame, the Progressive Aboriginal Relations certification program, the Foundation for the Advancement of Aboriginal Youth, and the Aboriginal Business Mentorship Program. ♦
