Bluffs and valleys in the area make it an area of natural beauty and opportunities for sport, recreation, and leisure. The city of 15,000 is only 50 miles from the metropolitan area of Minneapolis/St. Paul which provides additional resources for activities.

The Red Wing Campus

The Red Wing campus is located at the south edge of the city on top of the Mississippi bluffs. The campus is one large building so a student does not have to leave the building to attend different classes. The richness of the programs at the campus brings a variety of students in age and ability to it. This provides for a family atmosphere at the campus and a tradition of student social events.

The Winona Community

Winona is set on the Mississippi River with the backdrop of beautiful high bluffs and the countryside. It has a rich heritage dating back to the Indian mound builders, Father Louis Hennepin, and the lumber industry. Today's city of 26,000 supports a variety of mixed businesses that center around technology, manufacturing and farming. Its three institutions of higher learning bring a flavor all its own and add to the educational experiences available. Activities are plentiful for the adventuresome as well as the sedate. The conservative nature of the city helps bring a steadiness to the region.

The Winona Campus

There are two college campus sites in Winona. The main campus is at the south end of the city with a backdrop of Sugar Loaf bluff. The airport campus is located at the north end of the city. The campuses in Winona enjoy access to the four-lane highway that runs through Winona. This provides easy transport to points around town. The campuses employ state-of-the-art technology, including a number of expanded online courses available for teaching and student information access. This is reflected by the student access ratio of approximately four full-time students to each computer. There is a large student commons on the main campus for leisure activities between classes.
