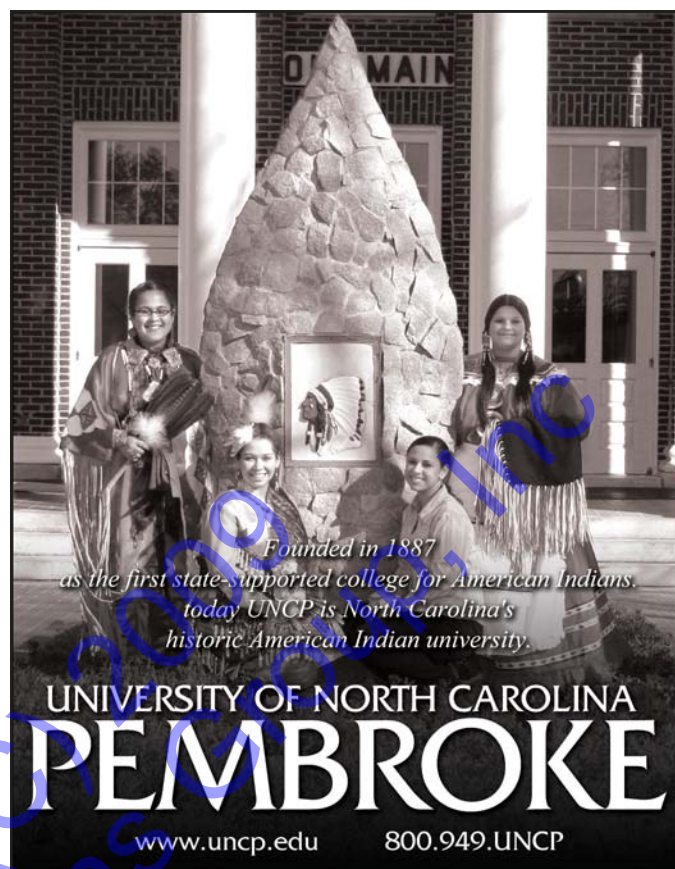

There are 43 undergraduate degree programs in the College of Arts and Sciences, the School of Business, and the School of Education. The Esther G. Maynor Honors College promotes the academic and personal growth of outstanding undergraduate students. Opportunities in the Maynor Honors College include special interdisciplinary courses taught in small seminars, cultural and service programs, and a residential area especially for honors students.

UNC Pembroke offers 16 master's degree programs in business administration, public administration, counseling, and several education areas. Currently, 660 graduate students are enrolled.

Students are encouraged to expand their horizons through participation in over 100 student organizations and honor societies, intramural athletics, and the well regarded Leadership and Service Opportunities Program.
