TRANSFER: Students who want to earn their BA/BS at a university can complete the first two years of study (general education classes or "GE"s) at LACC for A FRACTION OF THE COST of completing the same classes at the university.

- Academic assistance to aid you in becoming a more competitive university applicant.
- A Transfer Center to help you understand the requirements, and identify financial aid and support service resources at your target four-year university(s).

TRAIN: Prepare for high paying, in-demand careers in areas including the arts, business, child development, computer technology and applications, food services, health care, social services, and television & cinema.

- Most programs take only 2 to 6 semesters to complete.
- Most classes are only \$11/unit (CA residents).
- Several of our programs are exclusively offered at only one or two other community colleges in Southern California and/or have been recognized as outstanding by professional and educational organizations.
